Course: Appetizer - Marinated Cheese (contributed by Jacquie Rehner)

Cuisine: Italian

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup olive oil
- 1/2 cup white wine vinegar
- 3 Tablespoons chopped fresh parsley
- 3 Tablespoons minced green onions
- 3/4 teaspoons dried basil
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 3 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 2 ounce jar jar diced pimiento, drained
- 8 ounces block of Sharp Cheddar Cheese
- 8 ounce package of cream cheese

Instructions

- Combine first 9 ingredients in a jar, cover tightly, and shake vigorously. Set aside.
- Cut cheddar cheese in half-length wise, then cut crosswise into 1/4 inch slices. Set aside. Repeat with cream cheese.
- Arrange cheese slices alternating in a shallow baking dish, standing slices on edges.
- Pour marinade over cheese slices, cover and marinate in fridge at least 8 hours.
- Serve with your favorite crackers, celery or french baguette!

Meeting Minutes Wednesday, May 19, 2021

Attendees: Warmkessel, Stone, Davis/Gibson, Hanahran, , Bewes, Rehner, Mentzel/Miner, Wilson, guests Central Florida V.P. Bill Dees and Wife Carolyn, and Preston and Sherrill Russ.

Meeting called to order by President Jim Wilson and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag at 9:48am.

Jim gave the results of the electronic vote for the proposed By Law change. The By Law change will replace the word 'coach' with 'Recreational Vehicle', thus allowing towables. We currently have 56 members in the Roll 'n Rebels. The By Law change requires all members the opportunity to vote and it requires 65% affirmative vote. 36 votes were needed to amend the by law. 38 voted for the proposed change, 2 voted against.

Jim introduced the V.P. of Central Florida, Bill Dees and his wife Carolyn who were here visiting our chapter, as well as guests, Preston and Sherrill Russ. At that time Bill Dees thanked us for inviting him to visit, and talked about towables in FMCA.

Marlene discussed the upcoming rally schedule and the need for hosts. Jacquie and Fran offered to do the October rally at San Carlos RV Park & Island, Oct 15-17, 2021. The Warmkessels and Walters are hosting our November rally at Oak Alley RV resort, Nov 13-15, 2021. Gary explained that our November rally is Saturday thru Tuesday to give us the opportunity to take in the wonderful Webster Flea Market on Monday. The February rally at Paradise Oaks will be hosted by Mentzel/Miner and the Wilsons, Feb 20-22, 2022, and the April rally will be hosted by the Stones, April 7-10, 2022. Hosts needed for December, January, March and May.

Marlene added that its important that when you make your reservations to let the hosts know that you will be coming so that they can plan the food and activities. If you are planning on going to San Carlos, please make your reservations as soon as possible. We have 20 sites reserved, and have approximately 15 already with reservations. Marlene will try to get more sites if needed.

Gary made the motion to adjourn, with a second by Ellyn. Meeting adjourned at 10:19am.
